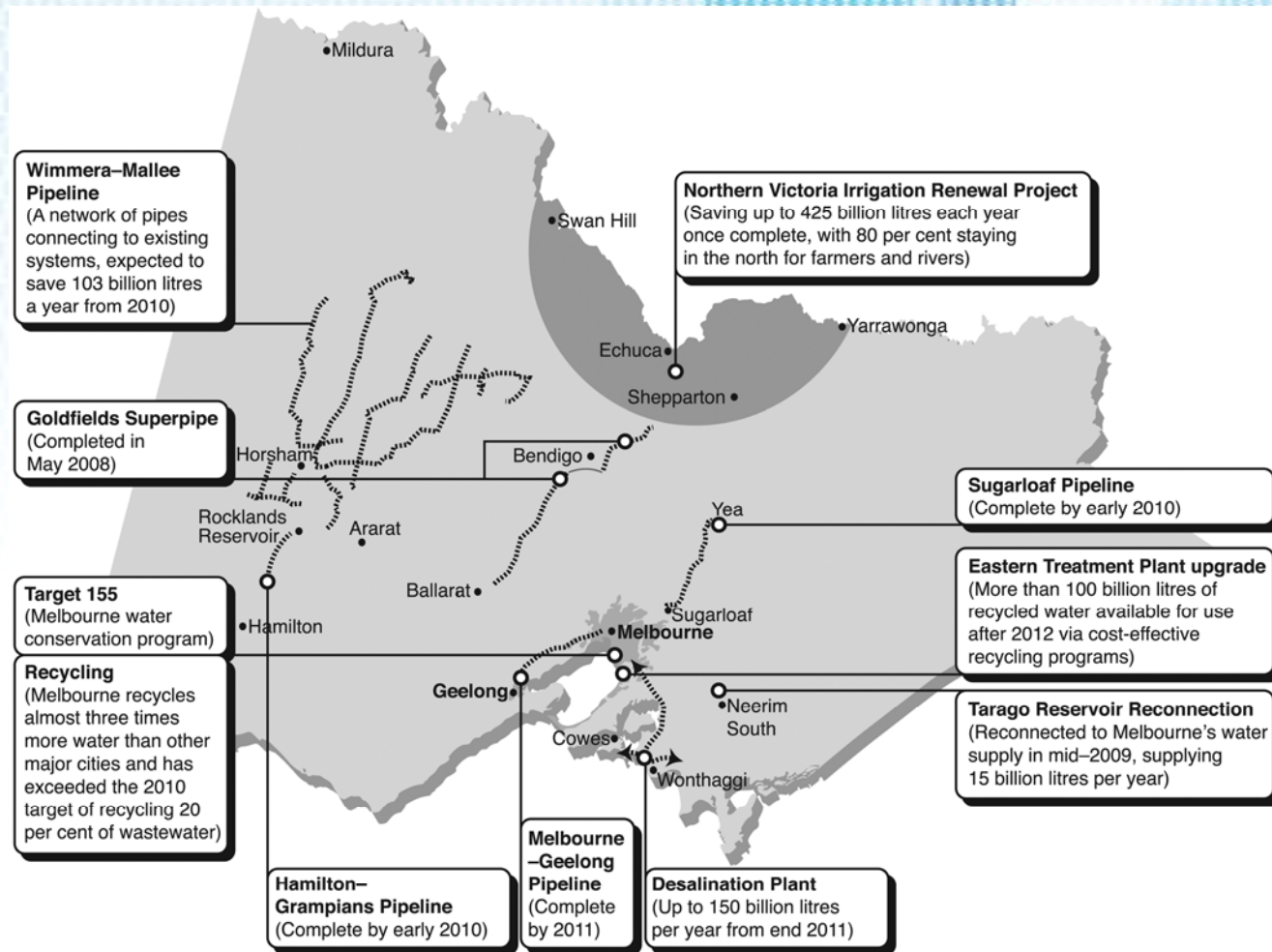

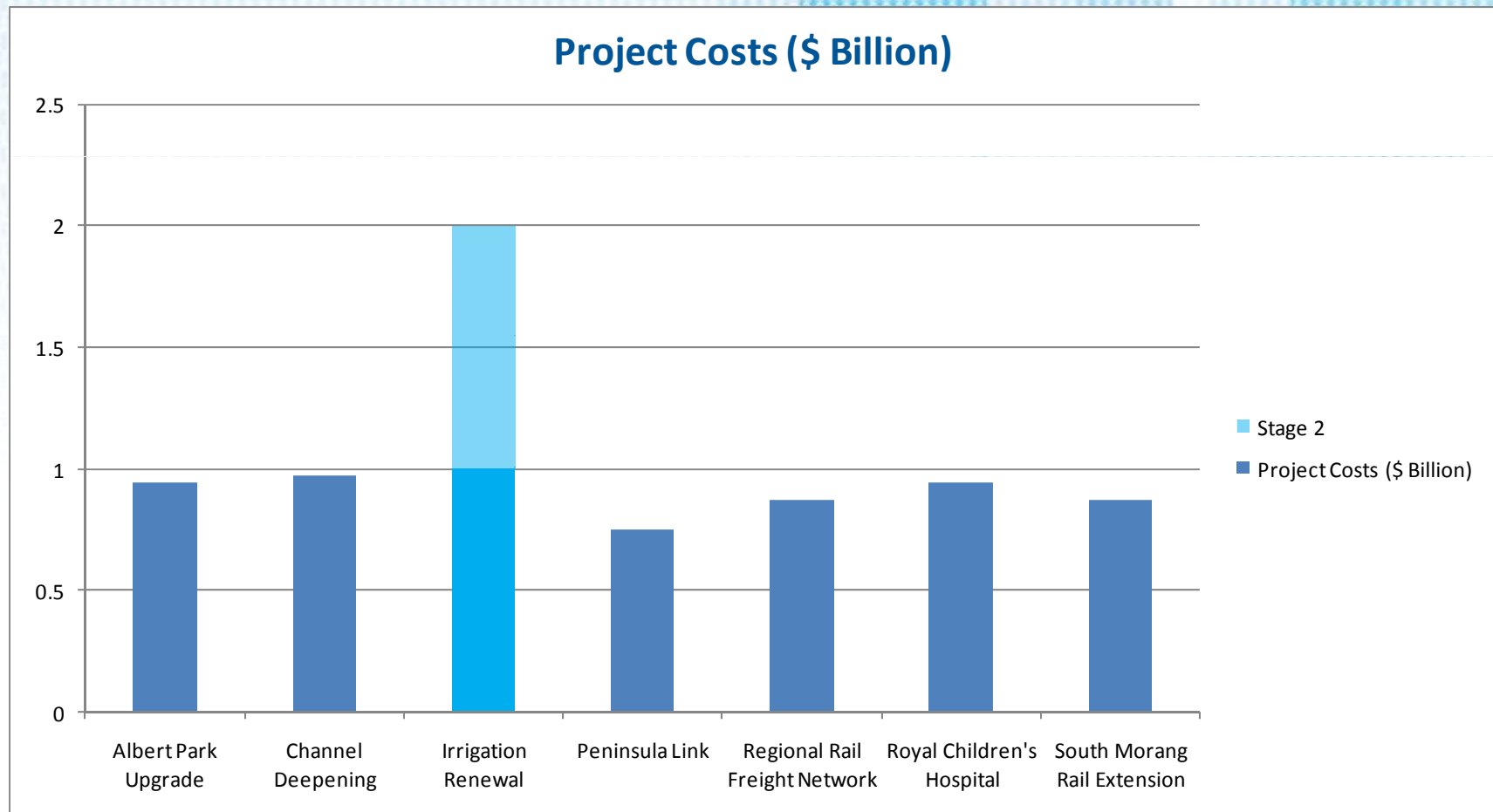

# Probity



- NVIRP (through Transfield Services) are required by government policy to ensure that these tender /procurement processes are consistent with probity
- Probity means “procedural integrity”
- a process which is accountable, free from bias and fair

# Probity



Government policy requires the following probity principles be observed by NVIRP in conducting tenders:

- Integrity and impartiality in all processes
- Use of a competitive process
- Consistency and transparency of process
- Security of confidential information
- Identification and resolution of conflicts of interest (potential, perceived or actual)

# Probity



- This means that NVIRP/TSA personnel involved in the tender must sign conflict of interest declarations;
- Systems must be set up to protect confidential information of tenderers and of the evaluation process;
- Tenderers are all told the same information – through a single managed point of contact

# Probity



- There is probity adviser appointed to the Program (Anne Dalton of Sparke Helmore) to:
  - Objectively and independently monitor procedural integrity
  - Report on probity issues as they may arise (risks and solutions)
  - Report against a Probity Plan and Probity Protocols
